1. We have been informed that fire clearance for the building at Narela has been granted on 28.10.2025 in respect of the ground floor and the first floor and further that for the clearance to the second and the third floor, certain suggestions have been made. Mr. Sameer Vashisht, learned counsel representing the respondent, has stated that those suggestions are in the process of being considered so far as the second and the third floors are concerned.
2. He has stated that in view of the aforesaid fire clearance, shifting of the residents from Timarpur to Narela building is likely to commence from 10.11.2025 which shall be completed by 10.12.2025.
3. Mr. Rungta, learned counsel representing the petitioner, also states that some direction may be issued for issuance of the advertisement for admission of the blind girls to the hostel. Mr. Vashisht, on instructions, has stated that the said advertisement is likely to be issued within ten days.
4. List on 17.12.2025 by which date a fresh status report shall be filed by Mr. Vashisht.

5. Status report filed by learned CGSC representing the Delhi Police be taken on record. As per the said status report in case of the death of Mr. Aditya, FIR bearing no. 342/2024 has been lodged on 29.08.2024 at police station Vijay Vihar, Rohini, Delhi. The investigation based on the said FIR is still going on. We expect that the investigation into the said FIR shall be concluded as early as possible.

6. In respect of the death of Mr. Ajju, who was also a resident of Asha Kiran, Avantika Sector-1, Rohini, Delhi, it has been stated that the investigation officer is in the process of seeking a third medical opinion. The second medical opinion is said to have been received on 13.08.2025, however, it appears that further steps have not been taken in these two and a half months. We expect that necessary steps in this regard shall also be taken by the investigating officer at the earliest.

7. List on 17.12.2025 by which date Delhi Police shall file a fresh status report in respect of the progress made in the criminal cases.
